# Where Minnesota Is Now LEADING THE NATION

On May 22, the last day of Minnesota's 2023 legislative session, both the Senate and House passed a newly revised health omnibus bill. Governor Walz signed it into law within a short time

This bill repealed a law that provided lifesaving care for infants born alive from abortion – a law that saved the lives of five babies born in 2021.

In addition, the new law repealed the Positive Alternatives to Abortion Grant program that provided alternatives to abortion for pregnant women in need. The result for Pregnancy Choices is a \$181,000 funding loss, effective July 1, 2023.

This funding loss will have an immediate and profound effect on the women and men served at Pregnancy Choices and the wrap around care we provide that is needed to move families from surviving to thriving.

In just five months the landscape of abortion in Minnesota has dramatically changed.
