"Do You Support Women Who Have Had An Abortion?"

We had an unusual call a few weeks ago. The voice on the other end of the line asked if we support women who have had an abortion? She was a college student, home on break. Just four days before she'd had an abortion

and needed to talk to someone. She came in for life coaching and the opportunity to process the experience. She spoke of her regret in choosing to end the life that she had helped create, and she was grieving.

The passing of Minnesota's PRO Act

The passing of Minnesota's PRO Act (Protect Reproductive Actions Act) on Jan. 31, 2023, guarantees the "right" to abort any baby, for any reason, at any time until birth. The unusual phone call we received a few weeks ago will become more commonplace.

We have witnessed the trauma that abortion can cause for women and men. We've heard personal stories of guilt and unforgiveness carried for decades, and we've read research on what can happen when this trauma is never addressed: depression, addiction, even suicide.

With the changes in MN law, it will be more important than ever that there


